There are 15 street lights in Whilton. Usually we hardly notice them. The challenge this week is to notice them and give each a suitable name.

To help you identify them, we have numbered them and described their positions.

1. At Whilton Locks, by the canal bridge. **Lock Light**
2. In Main Street, opposite the entrance to Langton Rise. **First Light**
3. In Main Street, outside Number 6, South View. **South Slope Light**
4. In Main Street, outside Number 2, South View. **Langton View Light**
5. In Main Street, at the bottom of the steps to South View. **13 Steps Light**
6. In Main Street, opposite Buckby Lane **Doctor's Light**
7. In Main Street, beside Dormer Cottage entrance **Sleepy Cottage Light**
8. At the Green, on the pole by the tree. **Eternal Light**
9. In Main Street, opposite Wadd Close Lane **Purple Light**
10. In Main Street, at the entrance to the Village Hall. **Welcome Light**
11. In Main Street, at the chained entrance to Rose Cottage. **Wasted Light**
12. At the triangle, beside the Manor Lane sign. **Whichway Light**

13. In Manor Lane, opposite the pond and outside Springfield House. **Have you got a light Guv? Light**

14. In Brington Lane, opposite Felines and Lower Farmhouse **Cat Like Light**

15. In Brington Lane, outside Woodview. **End of the world light**
