1. There are 6 public seats in Whilton village, and 6 at the Locks.
2. There are 14 half allotments in Whilton.
3. There usually 7 Parish Councillors, although there is currently one vacancy.
4. 20 is plenty in Whilton village
5. The height restriction under the railway bridge is 3.9m/12.9 feet.
6. There are 10 houses are in South View
7. There were 271 inhabitants of Whilton in the last census of 2011.
8. The School House was built in 1835.
9. Henry Reynolds won the VC in 1917.
10. There are 14 steps from the pavement up to South View
11. There are 6 spokes are on the Whilton wheel on the Green.
12. There are 16 glazed windows in the church.
13. The church provides 3 boot scrapers.
14. The number of the public telephone on the Green is 01327 8423297 and at the Locks 01327 842305
15. 4 ½ miles from the end of Manor Lane to Daventry.
16. The last post is collected on weekdays in the village and the Locks at 4 p.m
17. The current speed limit at the Locks is 40 MPH.
18. The number of the bridge over the canal at the Locks is 15.
19. 9 miles from the top of the village to Northampton.
20. Either 8 or 9 steps lead from the road up to The Gardens, depending on how you count them.
